## FAMILY JIGSAW PUZZLE NIGHT

**BELOW IS A FUN JIGSAW PUZZLE GAME YOU CAN DO WITH YOUR FAMILY NEXT TUESDAY.**

### **Supplies needed:**

- Puzzle
- Bowls/containers (1 per person)
- Pennies/other coins or play money (10 per person)
- One (1) die

### **Set up:**

- Handout bowl and 10 pennies to each person.
- As a group, create the entire boarder of the puzzle.
- Roll the die to see who goes first – highest number goes first and then go around table clockwise.
- Take turns picking the remaining pieces one at a time until all pieces are taken and place in each players bowl/container.

### **Object:**

- Be the first to get rid of all puzzle pieces in your bowl/container.
- Have Fun!



### **How to Play:**

- First person rolls the die.
- The number on the die tells you the number of puzzle pieces that you can add to the puzzle. You do not have to use all the amount shown on the die. .
- You have 4 options when it is your turn:
  1. You can place a puzzle piece on the puzzle, but it must connect to the border (or to any piece in the center, once the center is started). You can connect as many pieces as the number shown on the die.
  2. Skip your turn. If you choose to skip your turn you must take one puzzle piece from the person to your right.
  3. You have 10 pennies to use if you want to put down a puzzle piece that is not connected to the border or to another piece already in the center. You can only spend 1 penny each turn. If you choose to buy a free turn, you give the penny to the person on your left and you can place any piece from your bowl/container anywhere in the center of the puzzle.
  4. Once someone places a puzzle piece in the center, you can now build off that piece when it is your next turn.
